

‘Spirit of the Clover’ Requirements

1. Must be an **actively enrolled** Chelan or Douglas County 4-H member in ‘any project.’ Junior, Intermediate or Senior 4-H members are eligible.
2. You must be a **current student** of private, public, home school or graduate.
3. **Write an essay** titled: “ *Importance of the 4-H Program in my Community.*”
Junior essay: 200 words; Intermediate essay 350 words; Senior essay 500 words.
4. Current **letter of recommendation** from non-family member signed & dated by its author.
5. Documented **15 hours of community service** between Octobers 1st and the last Friday in July.
6. Up-to-date **Record Book** included in application on due date. (Will be returned on interview day.)
7. **Interview** with Clover judges. Date TBA
8. Two **Demonstrations**: 1. County Demonstration Day 2. Chelan County Fair.
9. **Attendance at Chelan County Fair** as an Exhibitor in your project and public participation as explained in ‘Agreement’ includes a requirement of a general knowledge about Ashley to share when you are asked. Horse project recipient will use the *Ashley Barnes* Spirit of the Clover stall and must participate in Fitting & Showing, Equitation, Pleasure and Trail Classes. ‘Other projects’ must participate in at least 3 classes that pertain to their project.
10. Participation in the Apple Blossom **Kids Parade** ‘Clover’ Entry.
11. Attendance at Chelan County end-of-the-year Awards Night in November.
